Coast Guard Group Key West becomes second 'Sector'

FROM COAST GUARD SECTOR KEY WEST PUBLIC AFFAIRS

Coast Guard Sector Key West was established at a ceremony held Thursday at the Coast Guard Group Key West in the Trumbo Point Annex.

Sector Key West is the second of eleven new Sector Commands that will be created nationwide this year and will improve the Coast Guard's ability to provide for the safety and security of the South Florida community.

By creating Sectors, the Coast Guard's command and control functions will be unified under one local operational commander, resulting in increased interaction and coordination across the Coast Guard's range of missions.

The new Sector Commands integrate Groups, Marine Safety Offices, Vessel Traffic Services, and in some cases, Air Stations to more effectively manage the sweeping changes to the Coast Guard's operational environment resulting from the attacks of September 11, 2001.

The single interface will also facilitate more efficient execution of homeland security missions.

To establish Sector Key West, the existing commands of Group Key West and Marine Safety Detachment Marathon will be combined into one unit led by the new Sector Commander, Capt. Philip Heyl.

Election year is here! Your calendars may read August but for voters who live out of state and haven't requested an absentee ballot, the time to request your ballot is NOW. Election day is less than 90 days away.

Unfortunately, many military votes did not get counted in the 2000 election.

Most of the problems resulted in absentee ballots not getting postmarked in a timely matter. That problem is being

addressed by installing postmark cancellation machines on all ships in the fleet. Postmark machines won't be useful if you and your families don't register.

It's important that you register early to allow enough time for the ballot to be received back and counted.

Registering to vote is easy. You can receive a Federal Postcard Application card from NAS Key West Voting Assistance Officer Senior Chief Aviation Ordnanceman Billy Welch by calling him at 293-3648 or e-mail welchbi@naskw.navy.mil. Forms and addresses can also be found online at www.fvap.gov/pubs/onlinefpca.html. While you're surfing online, don't forget to check out the Navy's Voting Assistance Program website at: www.persnet.navy.mil/nvap. This website will provide up-to-date election information, voter registration/feedback as well as election year do's and don'ts for members of the Armed Forces. Finally, NAS Key West will be holding a Voting Assistance and Information Fair next month, September 3-11. Watch the *Southernmost Flyer* for more information.

Like you, I often wondered if my one vote counted. Typing in the words "one vote difference" into your favorite Internet search engine will return dozens of web pages detailing instances where one vote made a difference.

I can't tell how historically accurate many of these claims are but few around Key West will forget the close contest in Florida's 2002 presidential election. In the final tally, a mere few hundred Florida votes determined the winner of the U.S. presidential race. One person who didn't think their voted counted isn't to blame. Sailors needed for occupational surveys

NORFOLK, Va.—Sailors still have time to complete occupational task surveys concerning how they perform their Navy jobs and help shape the future of individual ratings and specialties.

The Navy Manpower Analysis Center (NAVMAC), in coordination with the Naval Personnel Development Command's Learning Centers, is conducting the surveys, which are available for many ratings on Navy Knowledge Online (NKO) at www.nko.navy.mil.

The survey results will allow the Navy to validate occupational data - the actual work Sailors perform - with the goal of capturing the tasks and associated jobs in each rating and specialty. By doing so, the Navy will gain a broader picture of the work Sailors perform, and the NAVMAC team will be able to identify similar functions and consolidate training, saving money as a result.

"It's extremely important for Sailors to participate so that there can be an accurate collection of information. The collected data affects the future of the Navy and how the Navy will classify the workforce of the future," said Lt. Cmdr. Brian Willemssen, program manager, NAVMAC Occupational Standards at Navy Manpower Analysis Center in Millington, Tenn. "Currently, the Navy defines work only associated with ratings. Using the data developed through the survey, we will be able to define all Navy

work, irrespective of rating."

Since being announced in April, thousands of Sailors have logged onto their Learning Center page on NKO to complete their surveys, spending about 30 to 45 minutes on each. To participate, Sailors need to have been serving in their rating for 90 days or more, and should select jobs that most closely correlate to their current assignment. Individuals serving in specialty jobs will complete only specialty surveys, not those of their source ratings. These include instructor duty and Recruit Division Commander, for example.

While several rating surveys are still open, several have closed, including Legalman, Master-at-Arms and Explosive Ordnance Disposal/Navy Diver. Occupational data for these ratings has already been validated, meaning NAVMAC now can fully identify the jobs associated with these ratings. That is the next

step in matching specific Sailors with specific skills to specific jobs, vice assigning Sailors based on rating alone.

"Because of these surveys, the Navy's current Occupational Standards will be revamped. The data will provide us the means to define a job structure compliant with industry best practices, providing common ground to map military work with comparable commercial work," said Willemssen. "What that means for Sailors is that it will help to track their progress throughout their careers and to make their service time more closely correlate with the private sector."

While many Sailors have completed surveys, Willemssen said NAVMAC needs even more participation.

"I can't emphasize enough the importance of completing these surveys," he said. "I realize this takes time out from busy schedules, but these surveys will provide validated occupational

data, which is the foundation for the Navy's move toward the HR System that will be used in the future."

Commands with limited Internet access can obtain surveys on CD from the respective Learning Center. For technical difficulties, NAVMAC has set up a help desk (7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Central, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays). If calling after hours, individuals are encouraged to leave a voice message or an email including their name, command and contact information, as well as a description of the issue. 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

Online courses complement training for CPO transition

WASHINGTON — In a partnership with an online business skills training provider, Navy Knowledge Online (NKO) is once again delivering computer-based leadership courses to newly-selected chief petty officers for completion during their transition season. Two additional courses are being included in this year's training program.

The additional four hours of courses offered by the Ninth House Network include Optimizing Team Performance and Navigating Change. These courses have been added to the previous year's list of Situational Leadership II, Managing Change and Resolving Interpersonal Issues, for a total of 14 hours of Web-based learning.

Naval Education and Training Command Force Master Chief Michael McCalip said that last year's program was a tremendous success. Approximately 98 percent of the 5,418 active-duty, Reserve and TAR chief-selects enrolled and completed the program during the past year. He said considering last year's operational requirements, that number was higher than anticipated.

This year, to receive their Ninth House CDs, NKO users

can log on and order their discs by clicking on the leadership tab and scrolling down to click on the corresponding link. Selectees can have the CDs mailed to either home or work, and can expect to receive them within two weeks if mailed to a stateside location. If the Sailors already have their CDs, the courses can be accessed from the same area on NKO.

An additional improvement is that Sailors do not need to worry about entering these courses into their training record. Upon completion of the courses, their electronic training jacket and the Navy Training Management & Planning System (NTMPS) database will automatically be updated.

Protecting your identity

Ever lose your wallet or purse? How about your military ID card? Ever lose a PIN number? What about a credit card or driver's license? I suspect most people have at one time or another had something stolen that contained important personal information, like your name, address, Social Security number, or credit card number. If you have been a victim, you were vulnerable to one of the fastest-growing crimes in the world, identity theft.

Here's a quick quiz: Without looking in your wallet or purse, make a list of every document, card, or piece of data in there that someone could use to learn something about you. If you can't list them all, or don't know who you would call to report the loss of a particular credit card, you are more vulnerable than you might like to think.

In today's world of easy credit, you just can't be too careful especially considering how much information is available on the Internet.

In the past five years, more than 27 million Americans have been victims of identity theft, and Sailors are more susceptible than the general public. Last year's identity theft losses to businesses and financial institutions totaled nearly \$48 billion and consumer victims reported \$5 billion in out-of-pocket expenses. Why are Sailors more prone to this? Because Sailors move around a lot and that makes us more of a target. Identity theft is

not specific to rank, it affects us all, from Seaman to Admiral.

Identity thieves take advantage of two key things: sloppiness and inattentiveness. Think

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While you may guard your ID card, what about all the other documents that contain critical information? Ever throw an old LES in the trash? How about a copy of an eval or fitrep? What about all the junk mail you receive in the mail that contains all sorts of information about you? If you don't shred that stuff, and tightly control where you put it, it might end up in the wrong hands.

Identity theft happens when another person uses your personal information to commit fraud or other crimes. In some gross cases, people whose identity have been stolen can spend months, even years - and their hard-earned money - cleaning up the mess thieves have made of their good name and credit record.

In today's world of easy credit, you just can't be too careful, especially considering how much information is available and shared on the Internet. When I was growing up, getting a credit card was almost impossible. To obtain one, you had to fill out a huge amount of paperwork and prove, beyond a shadow of a doubt, you were "worthy" of credit.

Today, credit is given so freely that it's not uncommon to receive actual credit cards in the mail, and to activate it, all you need to do is make a simple phone call. If someone opens an account in your name, how would you know?

That brings me to the second

assumption by thieves, inattentiveness. Most of us receive bank and credit card statements either in the mail or have access to them on line. Do you read them? If you try to pay your bills quickly, and only make minimum payments to your credit cards, you may not even notice that someone made a purchase if you don't read the entire statement. Additionally, if someone opens an account in your name, and subsequently rings up some large purchases, you may not become aware until it shows up on your credit report as a delinquent account. If the billing address set up by a thief isn't your home address, you would never see the bills to know there was a problem.

Here's what I suggest to everyone. First, protect everything that contains personal data. Secondly, you should purchase a shredder so you can dispose of

any pieces of paper that come in the mail that contain information about you. Thirdly, I recommend you review your credit report often. There are several credit bureaus that provide credit reports: TransUnion, Experian and Equifax. There are many services that allow you to purchase your credit report so you can review it.

Here are a few more quick tips to help protect yourself: cancel unused credit cards; limit the number of cards you own; when using the Internet, make purchases only on secure sites - look for the little "lock" icon on sites that can be trusted; never give PIN numbers to anyone, for any reason; don't put PIN numbers in the same place as the accounts they access (like in your wallet); and if you use a computer, don't download or open files from strangers - opening a file could expose your sys-

tem to a computer virus or a program that could hijack your modem.

My final tip: If you suspect a credit card has been stolen, report it immediately. Don't wait - if you wait, someone might be shopping using your account.

Shipmates, I would encourage you all to take every precaution you can think of to protect yourself from identity theft. This white-collar crime is on the rise and all of us are vulnerable. I would challenge you to view identity theft like we do force protection - you can never completely eliminate yourself from being a target, but you can take measures to make yourself a hard target vice a soft target.

Following a few simple steps can greatly-reduce the two things would-be thieves need most, sloppiness and lack of attention. Good luck and stay safe!

'Learn or burn, baby, learn or burn'

USS Forrestal tragedy remembered

NORFOLK, Va. (NNS) — The thirty-seventh anniversary of

the USS Forrestal (CVA 59) tragedy was remembered at the Farrier Fire Fighting School in Norfolk, Va., Aug. 2.

The ceremony was attended by former crewmembers of the attack aircraft carrier, surviving family members and instructors from the fire fighting school.

The name of each Sailor killed during the tragedy was read, while a bagpiper played

"Amazing Grace" and the Navy hymn.

July 29, 1967, the attack aircraft carrier Forrestal was conducting wartime flight operations in the Gulf of Tonkin during the Vietnam conflict. After four days of successful air operations, the crew of Forrestal was abruptly forced to move its attention from the foreign conflict to fighting a massive flight deck fire.

One of the bombs on the flight deck exploded and caused a chain reaction of explosions.

"I thought that perhaps we were being attacked. And, after the explosions started going off so fast, I realized that it was something that was not caused by enemy action, but perhaps an accident on the ship," said Retired Senior Chief Ship's Serviceman Benjamin Wright, a Forrestal survivor from Virginia Beach, Va.

The incident killed 134 men and almost destroyed the ship. It also changed the way the Navy handles damage control.

"The Navy realized at the

time, well after the incident happened, that not enough Sailors on board the ship were trained properly how to combat a fire," said Lt. David Livingston, department head of Farrier Fire Fighting School. "Everyone aboard a ship now has the capability and the knowledge to at least start combating the fire before a more trained team arrives."

The Navy built on lessons learned on Forrestal and continues to improve training to prevent future disasters.

"I think if there were any errors made, safety violations, etc., that they've since been corrected," said Wright.

continue to better prepare CPOs for 21st century leadership," said McCalip. "These programs are focused on them and are more education-based than training. It exposes them to a

different type of learning and shows our chief-selects one of the many education options out there."

The courses are delivered through a combination of both the Internet and NetCD(r) packets. NKO provides the portal for Sailors to access and log in for the training. The NetCD(r)

packets also help with bandwidth limitations by providing each course's multimedia files, avoiding the need to download the files.

"Our chief petty officers have taken ownership of this mission and are devoted to its success," said Master Chief Petty Officer of the Navy (SS/AW)

Terry Scott. "Continuing to invest in our future leaders by providing them the proper training they need to be successful is only the beginning of the Navy's investment in its future leaders. By continuing to provide knowledge and sharpen their skills, it will serve these chiefs well into their future as

deckplate leaders."

According to Scott, online learning will continue to be a more useful tool in training and developing leadership skills, as well as professional knowledge.

"This method of transferring knowledge to our Sailors will become more and more common" he said.
