"It's never easy being a military wife with all the deployments and travel," Denise Zastrow said. "My husband is the reason for my strength while he is deployed."

While in Iraq, Lt. Legg served as the Marine Expeditionary Group (MEG) Liaison Office to the 1st Marine Division. He was responsible for coordinating Seabee engineering construction efforts with the Marine ground combat element.

ing his unique skills to the MEG Intelligence Officer as a plotting and overlay expert.

He jokingly described the experience as, "Pretty much the same as life here. Just take away friendly civilians, beer, cell phones, DSL, your car, your bed, bathrooms, and fast food. And, don't forget to add big booms, poorly cooked food, and being put on lockdown for six or seven months and that's what it's like serving in Iraq."

While deployments often coincide with holidays, birthdays and other special events and holidays, the Zastrows were reunited just in time for their 11-year wedding anniversary. The Legg family was also reunited in time to celebrate their 5-year wedding anniversary and Lt. Legg also returned for his son's 1st birthday.

Equal Opportunity is a readiness issue and the commanding





harassment and discrimination at the command. They report EO matters to the CO via the executive officer (XO), when applicable.

Other duties include: assisting personnel in resolving conflict and complaints, to include guidance and counseling, ensuring SITREPs are submitted as required, coordinating and monitoring all EO training, serve as the coordinator for the Command Climate Assessment, maintain records of ongoing and closed out complaints, and performing other EO related duties as mandated by the CO.

The role of the CMEO Manager is very diverse. The CMEO Manager is the single point of contact for EO issues, to include sexual

We are very fortunate at NAS Key West, because the CMEO Manager does not have to perform their responsibilities alone. An Equal Opportunity Advisor (EOA) has been assigned here as well.

What is the role of the EOA? The EOA is the primary resource for the CMEO Manager and command leadership. EOAs are not assigned as CMEO Managers due to a conflict in roles and responsibilities.

Some of their duties include: serve as advisors and subject matter experts to the CO on EO issues, ensure required reports are submitted through the chain of command, conduct Chief of Naval Education and Training EO training to the Command Assessment Team (CAT) and Command Training Team (CTT), screen prospective EOA candidates, assist other commands with EO concerns and complaints, consolidate formal incident reports, and to help CMEO Managers, area wide, set up their command CMEO programs.

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Information Age will better prepare 'Digital Generation' Sailors

CNO invites leaders from industry, academia to join Navy Training

ARLINGTON, Va. (NNS) — The Navy will employ revolutionary technology and training theories to better prepare Sailors for the opportunities and challenges of the new millennium, Chief of Naval Operations Adm. Vern Clark said during his Aug. 11 address to the Learning Strategies Consortium.

To help accelerate the Navy's Revolution in Training, Clark called for partnerships with the industrial, academic and government leaders as well as gaming, simulation, and education experts at the Naval Education and Training Command-sponsored consortium.

"Our asymmetric advantage is the partnership that we can create with you," Clark said. "I'm so pleased that we have members of industry and academia, learning experts from all over the place. Because, ladies and gentlemen, we need your help to go as fast as we can and bring all the technology to bear because the clock is still ticking."

The gaming and simulation technology and learning theo-



ries the Navy is melding together will not only benefit the Sailors who learn from them, Clark added, but will also change the way other organizations view training in the future.

"You are important to the United States Navy and fundamentally, I believe, for America," the CNO said. "Because I believe we are on a journey that's going to change the way we grow and develop Americans, not just Navy people."

To underscore the signifi-

cance of the consortium, Clark outlined the evolution of the Revolution in Training from the Executive Review of Naval Training, to the creation of Task Force EXCEL to the establishment of the Human Performance Center.

"We're now at the point where we've got to deliver all the tools," the CNO said. "We've got to create them and deliver them."

According to Clark, the Navy is creating Information Age training constructs to better prepare

"Digital Generation" Sailors to grow, develop and maintain the skills necessary to serve, lead and make a difference.

"We believe in our commitment to life-long learning and presenting them with systems that allow them to continue to grow. The skill maintenance function is a very, very important issue here," he added.

"We're talking about the digital generation, and they are going to knock us out with what they can do - if we just give them

How many credit cards do you have? Two? Five? Ten? The fact is, no matter how many cards you have, almost all Americans, Sailors included, tend to purchase more than they can afford on their annual income. It's easy to spend more than you make because of credit. Now, before anyone starts to think I'm against credit, let me say that I'm a big fan of it...as long as it's used smartly. Most of us have varying amounts of credit — it's the way we make most major purchases. Used correctly, credit allows us to enjoy today what we will pay for tomorrow.

On average, according to the Business Journal Online, Americans carry \$2,294 in credit

card debt. The number of credit cards in the average person's wallet or purse is 2.3.

I was surprised to learn the average debt was so low. I often hear people have many more cards, and much more debt...so perhaps this is good news for all of us. But keep in mind, these are average figures; many people have many more cards and carry huge amounts of debt incurred on high-interest credit cards.

When I read some of the statistics about credit and debt, I started to think about credit management and that's what I would like to talk with you about this week.

Who taught you how to obtain credit? Who taught you how to get the best interest rates? If you say your parents or teachers,

that's great, but I'm not sure that's the most common answer. For the average Sailor, I suspect the Navy provides him or her with their first real serious amount of money, and their first opportunity for credit. Unless things have changed a great deal, most people in high school work, but manage to spend almost everything they make on clothes, entertainment or their vehicles. I know when I first started working, I was just happy receiving a little cash and didn't think much about saving any of it for later.

I believe most Sailors learn credit management the hard way, by trial and error...and the errors can be costly. In the beginning, credit is great. Credit allows you to purchase all the things you don't have enough money for. The most prevalent answer I get from Sailors about why they charge purchases on a credit card is, "because it allows me to have something today and pay for it over time." That's not a bad answer unless the interest rates on their cards are high.

Credit can get Sailors into

financial trouble quickly. Because credit allows a person to only pay minimum payments on purchases, people often ring up large debts because they can handle the small monthly payments. The problem is, if you do the math, making minimum payments can cost you a huge amount of interest over time. My point is — how smart is it to purchase a television at 10 percent off if you put it on a credit card that has a high interest rate and you only make minimum payments? The truth is, you could end up spending a huge amount of money more by paying over time.

Here are a few tips I have learned to use credit wisely:

* If at all possible, save up the money for a major purchase and don't use a credit card.

* For major purchases, consider a loan from a bank or credit union. Often the interest rates from banks are lower than credit cards.

* Little things add up. If you use a credit card, use it only for major purchases, not your day-to-day expenses.

* Use just one credit card so it's easy to monitor your statements. Also, in case of theft or loss, it's easier to report a single card than multiple cards.

* Pay more than the minimum bill each month. Paying only the minimum may mean you pay for years.

Finally, if you find yourself getting in financial trouble because of credit card debt, consider a consolidation loan from a bank or credit union. Often you can lump all your bills together and reduce your interest and monthly payment. Another superb source of help is the Fleet and Family Support Center. There are qualified counselors at each center who can help you devise a debt reduction plan based upon your budget...but I would suggest going to see a counselor BEFORE the wolves start to circle. What I mean is, go see a counselor before you start getting the letters of indebtedness and nasty notes from creditors. If you need financial help, asking for it early is always better than later.

Navy establishes Diversity Directorate

WASHINGTON (NNS) — With a clear strategic vision of incorporating diversity into the very fabric of the Navy organization, the Diversity Directorate was established Aug. 2 in a ceremony held outside the Directorate spaces at the Navy Annex.

The new directorate will bolster the Chief of Naval Operations' (CNO) vision to create a sense for everyone that the Navy is committed to their personal growth and development

from the moment they begin naval service.

"Leveraging the diversity of all our people makes us more operationally capable by cultivating all our differences...to help us make better decisions...decisions that, in turn, make us more agile, more flexible and more effective," said Vice Adm. Gerry Hoewing, Chief of Naval Personnel. "I am proud of our commitment to diversity and feel strongly that our superb readiness today is the direct result of the time and attention we have devoted to improving it."

With this step, the Navy signals to Sailors and civilians that their diversity is valued for the innovative ideas and unique experiences they bring to the fleet.

"The Diversity Directorate's mission is to assist Navy leaders in creating an environment that

encourages and enables our creative and innovative Sailors and civilians to reach their personal and professional potential," said Capt. Syd Abernethy, the new head of the Navy Diversity Directorate in Washington, D.C.

Seeing a direct relationship between diversity and mission readiness, Chief of Naval Operations Adm. Vern Clark added new focus on diversity in his Guidance for 2004. Clark expanded the traditional focus of diversity beyond race and gender, and folded in a Sailor's creativity, culture, ethnicity, religion, skills and talents.

"The advent of new technology and the resultant speed at which lethal decisions are made require more creative and innovative Sailors," Abernethy said.

With retention and recruitment at the highest levels in recent history, the Navy can now afford to focus on shaping the

force, ensuring the best-qualified, most diverse candidates are challenged to seek leadership roles in the senior enlisted and officer ranks of the future. To focus on the strategic diversity mission, the Directorate is divided into four working groups: Accessions, Training and Development, Organizational Alignment and Communications.

The Accessions group is determined to ensure that the Navy is presented to the best and brightest potential enlisted and officer candidates available across the entire spectrum of American society. They will seek out highly qualified and skilled candidates, ensuring the Navy is presented to a diverse audience at all academic levels.

The Training and Development group strives to embed the Navy's diversity vision into all Sailor and civilian

leadership training and management tools. It seeks to create a culture that values diversity through continuous education and training of Sailors and civilians, promoting individual success through opportunities and access to develop their knowledge, skills and abilities to their fullest potential. The group will track, monitor and assess promotion, advancement, program selections, and retention rates of all Sailors and civilians, and use results as trend indicators and guides for success.

The Organizational Alignment group will develop

and maintain an organizational structure that ensures diversity initiatives and programs are integrated and aligned within the Navy. Two examples are the Diversity Senior Advisory Group (DSAG) chaired by the Vice CNO with members from the Navy, industry, academia, and retirees that will act as a standing body of influence to advise our most senior leaders on trends and diversity

best practices. The second is the Diversity Fleet Council, with members from across the Navy, who will provide unfiltered feedback on diversity issues and will assist in execution of the Navy's diversity initiatives.

Finally, the Communications Group will inform and educate all Sailors, active and reserve, their families, retirees and Department of the Navy civilians about the current diversity initiatives, programs and opportunities. They will also work to keep the general public, poten-

tial recruits, media, and legislative and affiliated groups informed about the Navy diversity programs.

The ceremony marked the beginning of a new strategic focus not the end of a program development. "This is not the end - we can always do better - especially when it comes to sewing diversity into the fabric of our culture, and that's what we are trying to achieve here today," said Hoewing. "This new directorate will bring a new level of awareness to the fleet."

KISS & POISON REVIEW


Two front men, one incredible concert

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CONCEP offers win-win situation

A class of 13 first-term Sailors successfully completed Naval Air Station Key West's inaugural

Career Options and Navy Skills Evaluation Program (CONSEP) Thursday.

The four-day course covered personal planning, financial planning, Navy career options and career planning. Each of the four main topics, called modules, was then broken down into sub-topics offering a more in-depth explanation of each module.

"CONSEP is designed to give

our first-term sailors a reality check," said NCC Shane Morgan, Command Career Counselor and CONSEP administrator. "CONSEP also stresses the importance of taking advantage of every program the Navy offers to improve yourself and better prepare for life outside the service."

That message sank in pretty clearly for the CONSEP participants, particularly

regarding educational opportunities. "Now I know not to miss out on the programs the Navy College has to offer," said FC2 Bryan Tolbert, CONSEP participant.

Offering a course like CONSEP demonstrates where the Navy is heading with its Quality of Service initiative, according to CMDCM (SW) Kraig Holubar, NAS Key West Command Master Chief. "Early in my career, the

Navy saw Sailors, particularly junior Sailors, as objects rather than people," he said. "They [the Navy] have come to realize that Sailors are human beings and need to be treated as such."

CONSEP offers a win-win situation, Holubar said. "Even if Sailors take this course and separate from the Navy, they will be better prepared to become more productive civilian citizens," he added.

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
