

## Navy Ball tix on sale Weds.

Tickets for Key West's Navy Ball, scheduled for Friday, Oct. 15, go on sale Wednesday, Sept. 15. This year's Navy Ball will celebrate the 229th birthday of the United States Navy.

"The Navy Ball is a very popular event here in Key West and it typically sells out," said Lt. Ken Thompson, officer-in-charge of Aircraft Intermediate Maintenance Detachment Key West and this year's Navy Ball chairman. "Tickets will be sold to active duty military beginning Sept. 15. Department of Defense civilians, retirees, and others eligible to attend can buy their tickets a week later on Sept. 22. I encourage everyone to buy them

early because they won't last."

Prices for Navy Ball tickets vary depending on pay grade. Enlisted persons E-4 and below will be charged \$15 for their ticket and their guest; enlisted persons E-5 and 6 will be charged \$25; senior enlisted E-7 and above and officers will be charged \$30. Non-military guest tickets cost \$35. Retired Navy guests will pay the price of their rank at retirement.

The Navy Ball will be held at Trumbo Palms from 5:30 p.m. until the band stops playing. The Ball committee guarantees a good time and hopes to see many active duty Key West Sailors and their invited guest or guests. Childcare will be provided at Trumbo Point for a nominal fee and reservations must be made in advance.

"It was a great Ball last year and we expect this one to be even better," said Thompson. "The guest speaker will be Rear Adm. Red Best,

## Keeping their eyes on the 'eye' of Ivan for us

*How the Navy's Key West weather detachment works for us*

The Naval Atlantic Meteorological and Oceanographic Detachment (NLMOD) located on Boca Chica is in the business of keeping service members informed of upcoming tropical events. NLMOD sets Conditions of Readiness (COR's) to alert residents of a possible tropical event affecting the Florida Keys. Tropical Cyclone Conditions of Readiness begin with COR Five, set on June 1 and lasting until

November 30, which simply lets all members know that it is hurricane season. This is the time all service members should start preparing for a possible tropical event in Key West. When a tropical cyclone approaches our local area, NLMOD begins to analyze the strength and the track of the storm. A storm that has or is forecasted to have sustained fifty-knot winds passing over our local area will call for the setting of further Conditions of Readiness.

A tropical cyclone with sustained winds of 50 knots could cause considerable damage to the Florida Keys and pose a threat to human life. Depending on the category of the storm a decision will be made whether service members and their families will go to a hurricane shelter or evacuate to the mainland. When a tropical cyclone is on a track of possibly affecting Key

## Physical fitness assessment

Hurricane season reminds us of one of the many challenges of living in a place like Key West. I've discovered one other obvious challenge that Sailors here face every day: a wide array of restaurants and bars. These temptations are choices. You ultimately decide whether or not to "super size" or have "one more for the road".

The Navy gave me a tool for measuring the health and fitness of its Sailors and officers. That tool is the physical readiness standards. According to Navy instructions, the mandatory, biannual fitness readiness test was designed for commanding officers to understand and evaluate the health and fitness

of the Sailors assigned to them. Looking at a stack of performance evaluations recently, I was surprised at the number of NAS Key West Sailors who failed the fitness test. With the next physical fitness test scheduled for November, the time to prepare is NOW!

If your personal fitness slipped over the summer, don't try to get back into shape too rapidly. The Naval Safety Center cites poor health fitness and overexertion as one of the leading causes of Sailor's injuries and death, second only to the failure to wear seat belts. Your best

course to staying healthy is a regular exercise program. The Morale Welfare and Recreation Department provides excellent fitness facilities at Boca Chica, Sigsbee, Trumbo and soon, Truman Annex, for Sailors to stay healthy.

Experts agree that a 30-minute fitness regime, twice a week will keep you healthy. You still need to watch what you eat. The physical fitness assessment includes measuring body fat. Navy standards require Sailors to pass both portions of the assessment. I find it alarming that there are Sailors at NAS Key West who pass the body fat portion of the assessment but fail to pass the physical fitness test.

Health is an important safety factor, both for the individual and the Navy. Sailors who eat poorly and are out of shape fatigue quicker than those who are healthy. Fatigue is a killer for those who decide to take short

cuts or ignore safety precautions. In emergency situations, survival rates are higher for healthy and fit people involved in life threatening situations.

Remember the joke of two men being chased by a big bear? One man stops running and pulls out a pair of running shoes from his backpack. The other guy laughs and asks if he really thought he could out run the bear with running shoes. His partner answered, "I don't have to out run the bear. I just need to out run YOU!"

If you haven't started preparing for the physical readiness assessment, start now! Staying in shape is as important as knowing your rating.

You can't advance without passing the physical fitness assessment. Know the standards you need to achieve. Don't be the one who gets passed when a big bear is in the chase.

## Recent NAS construction projects support AT/FP

The Resident Officer in Charge of Construction (ROICC)

Office is in the process of completing another successful project. You may have noticed the construction work near the Boca Chica visitor quarters and the Fly Navy Building at Trumbo Point Annex. The purpose of this work has been to provide a 25-meter/82-foot vehicle stand-off distance that meets Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection (AT/FP) requirements.

The first phase of the contract handled the Fly Navy Inn AT/FP, where work is drawing to a close.

The work included construction of a new parking lot, landscaping, and a concrete bollard/cable vehicle barrier around the building.

The second phase includes work at Boca Chica. Included in this phase of the project are swing gates and removable cables for securing roadways/vehicle entrances at higher threat levels, as well as the bollards and steel cables generally surrounding the buildings. Work is being done along

Saratoga Avenue and Forrestal Street, and will continue on other smaller roads.

As with other road projects, the contractor's workers are required to be near moving traffic. Even though the speed limit is low on base, please help pass the word to "give 'em a brake" so we fully support Capt. Scholl's "100 Days Without a Lost Time Mishap" goal.

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## 3 new classes to improve leadership skills and techniques

In order to keep up with ever changing leadership roles and improvements to Sailors' development and professionalism, three new classes, the First Line Leadership Development Program (FLLDP), Primary Leadership Development Program (PLDP), and Advanced Leadership Development Program (ALDP) have emerged from the Naval Leadership Training Continuum (NLTC).

Previously, the leadership courses were only available to petty officers in pay grades E-4 to E-7, regardless of the individual's leadership role. The new classes are designed to better meet the needs of people in leadership positions.

"The classes are now aligned with a Sailor's leadership role in the command vice their pay grade. This will ensure that Sailors are getting required leadership training that is commensurate with their responsibilities," said CMDCM (SW) Kraig Holubar, Naval Air Station Key West's command master chief.

"These changes also support the Navy's revolution in training and the move to the 5 Vector Model (5VM)," Holubar added.

The First Line Leadership Development Program (FLLDP) is for Sailors in pay grades E-3 to E-5 who are in a "first leadership position" within their chain of command. These Sailors are those who are

responsible for the growth, development and daily direction of their subordinates.

The Primary Leadership Development Program (PLDP) is for those E-5 to E-6 Sailors who will be assigned leadership roles and responsibilities that include planning and executing divisional functions. They will also be responsible for the professional and personal growth of personnel within their division.

The Advanced Leadership Development Program (ALDP) is for first class petty officers and chief petty officers who are assigned to leadership roles and responsibilities in the administration, supervision and training of their division or department, including the professional and personal growth of personnel within that division or department.

According to Holubar, the course curriculum was also significantly modified to include instruction in e-learning.

The new course involves in-class instruction mixed with computer e-learning on the Navy Knowledge Online (NKO) Web site. For this reason, all Sailors assigned must have a NKO account (username and password) prior to attending the course.

The e-learning portion of the course is done on the NKO Web site, and the students' progress and course completion will be logged directly on the Professional Development vector of the 5VM.

All Sailors must complete FLLDP prior to taking the Navy-wide exam for E-6. However, completion of the E-5 NLTC course satisfies the requirement of FLLDP.

Completion of FLLDP is required for enrollment in PLDP, and PLDP is required to take the Navy wide exam for E-7. Previous completion of the E-6 NLTC satisfies the requirement of PLDP.

PLDP is required for enrollment in ALDP, and ALDP is required for advancement to E-8. Previous completion of the E-7 NLTC course satisfies the requirement of ALDP.

Written authorization from

the first flag officer in the chain of command is needed to waive any of the above requirements, but according to Holubar, waivers are difficult to justify and normally not approved.

Members of the Mobile Training Team (MTT) from Mayport, Fla., teach the courses.

There is a waiting list, and classes are limited to 24 people. MTT Mayport determines the yearly number and schedule of classes based on the southeast region area population.

Sailors who meet the criteria and need to attend one of the courses must contact their departmental training coordinator as soon as possible.

Holubar said supervisors must consider the importance of the class and nightly homework assignments, and not over task the students who are in attendance.

"Parent commands must ensure that students attending leadership courses are not assigned duties which interfere with the conduct of the course," Holubar said. "Attendance at class and completion of homework are considered primary duties while Sailors are attending LDP."



## Sailor suggestions on effectiveness, efficiency make a difference

WASHINGTON (NNS) — Sailors can make a difference

and create a more effective and efficient Navy by finding more practical ways to accomplish their missions, and report them through the Beneficial Suggestions (BeneSugs) and Military Cash Awards Programs (MilCap).

During a recent Echelon II visit by Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) Adm. Vern Clark, Commander, Navy Region Northeast leaders pointed to a couple examples of how Sailors found significant efficiencies in their region through the BeneSugs and MilCap programs.

"We have extraordinary people with great skills in our

Navy," Clark said in an interview later that day. "What this all means to me is we can have the greatest technology in the world - which we do - but none of it matters without the genius of our people."

As subject matter experts in their respective fields, Sailors have the unique experience and insight into the processes that keep the Navy in motion.

By taking their ideas on how to improve operations, enhance safety or save resources and putting them on the OPNAV 5305/1 form, Sailors can make money while saving the Navy money. In return, Sailors not

only benefit from a better Navy but can also earn up to \$25,000 in awards, depending on the safety or financial impact of their suggestion.

"Our goal is to enhance our mission accomplishment and deliver a combat-credible Navy now and in the future," Clark said in his 2004 Guidance. "It demands enterprise-wide approaches and innovation to achieve greater effectiveness and efficiency in afloat and ashore operations, readiness and infrastructure."

As a part of Sea Enterprise, an enabling initiative of Sea Power 21, the CNO has called for a cul-

ture that rewards greater effectiveness and removes institutional hurdles that block innovation.

Giving the Sailor and the taxpayer the best possible return on their investment in the Navy is the CNO's goal, and the BeneSug and MilCap programs are another way Sailors can help achieve it.

## New Navy working uniforms on the horizon

WASHINGTON (NNS) — Task Force Uniform (TFU) announced the completion of a solicitation for contracts, Aug. 31, for various uniform accessories to be used in an upcoming wear test of service and working uniforms. The contracts for all components of the wear-test uniforms are now nearly complete.

This solicitation outlined the final components that will be required from potential bidders to construct the test uniforms for TFU. The contracts for the Navy Working Uniform (NWU) for E-1 through O-10, and year-round service uniform for E-6 and below have already been awarded.

A variety of colors are currently being looked at as options and are being considered based on colors that have been traditionally found in the Navy's history,

The practicality of those colors are to be tested in a working environment, said Chief of Naval Operations-directed Command Master Chief (SS) Robert Carroll, the director of TFU.

"Once we have the finalized concept uniforms completely constructed, we will be able to release photos of the wear-test uniforms," said Carroll.

The wear-test sites have not yet been determined; however, various logistical supply points in the major fleet concentration areas were identified in the solicitation.

The sites for the wear test are currently being developed through the fleet and force master chiefs, based on those individual commands' ability to support all components of the wear-test program.

It is anticipated that more than 1,000 participants at 17 sites will test the NWU, and more than 500 Sailors at 11 sites will test the year-round service uniform. These final numbers and site locations may vary, depending on command/unit availability to participate.

"The individual commands that are now being identified by force master chiefs must represent their warfare community,

be working in an industrial environment (for the Navy Working Uniform), and adequately represent Navy demographics," said Carroll. "Commands must also be reachable for the duration of the wear-test period, operating within consistent communication capability. The most important piece is they must volunteer.

"Individuals volunteering must also be above-average performers, have enough time remaining at their current command to complete the wear test, and be within Navy readiness standards," he said.

With nearly all of the contracts awarded, TFU is beginning to look ahead to how the Sailors involved in the wear-test will provide feedback about the new uniforms.

"We're now concentrating on the method by which we'll communicate with the Sailors throughout the wear test, which we plan to do via electronic communication," said Carroll. "Our goal is to receive real-time data from our participants. That's something we've never done before."

West, COR Four will be set at the 72-hour mark. At that point NLMOD's forecasters will be working around the clock to determine the exact track and strength of the approaching storm. A decision will be made by the 48-hour mark whether it is necessary to go to hurricane shelters or to evacuate. At the 48-hour mark COR Three will be set. If the approaching storm is forecasted to be a Category 1 or 2 hurricane non-essential service members and their families will begin preparing to go to their designated hurricane shelters. If the storm is forecasted to be a Category three to five hurricane, non-essential service members and their families will begin evacuating. Therefore it is very important to stay in touch with your commands if a hurricane is approaching the Florida Keys. The only person who can

authorize a government-funded evacuation is the commanding officer of NAS Key West.

Further Conditions of Readiness will be set as the hurricane approaches, COR 2 is set at the 24-hour mark and COR 1 will be set at the 12-hour mark. These particular COR's will be extremely important if the decision is made to go to hurricane shelters. Hopefully everyone will have their hurricane kits prepared and be ready to go to their designated shelters. Hurricane kit information can be obtained at the Fleet and Family Support Center and designated shelter information will be available at your commands.

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## CNO praises partnership between sea services

ARLINGTON, Va. — The Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard are working together more closely today than they ever have before to confront the myriad threats America and its allies face around the world, Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) Adm. Vern Clark said during a Sept. 7 panel of sea service leaders.

Appearing together with Marine Corps Commandant Gen. Michael Hagee and Coast Guard Commandant Adm. Thomas Collins, the CNO told the Marine Corps Association and U.S. Naval Institute Forum that the current global threat

environment is blurring the lines between the services, and the roles they play in the defense of the nation at home and aboard.

"People want to draw the world up in perfect, finite pieces. My view is the world doesn't exist that way today and will exist less that way in the future," Clark said. "We speak to this principle throughout our joint discussions, that we need to blur all of those lines because the world does not exist with great clarity to where I can say what's on this side of the line is mine and what's on this side of the line is (Coast Guard Commandant Adm. Thomas Collins) Tom's. It just isn't that kind of globe anymore."

To more effectively employ the combined defense capabilities of the Navy and the Coast Guard, Clark said the two services are working on Maritime Domain


Awareness to protect the nation's shores.

"That's a big part of what our domain awareness is all about," the CNO said. "Tom and I are now working on this effort (Maritime Domain Awareness) that has now grown to the interagency level."

"A key issue for us is what's going on across that key transition zone between sea and land," Clark said.

The CNO said the Navy/Marine Corps team must better exploit the maritime domain - the world's oceans and the airspace above them - to bring joint capabilities to bear that are capable of deterring or defeating current and future threats.

"My view of the future is, we've got to be out and about," Clark said. "We are and will continue to

be able to bring the capability from the domain that allows us freedom to maneuver. We are fundamentally a maneuver force.

For this nation to have the kind of capability that it needs, it must be able to exploit the maneuver space that we own."

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
