

Dredger uncovers WWII-era anti-submarine ordnance

While continuing an 18-month dredging project to return the Key West channel to its original dredged depth of 34 feet, the Maricavor dredger uncovered a Mark 10 Hedgehog projectile. The Mark 10 Hedgehog was used between World War II and the Korean War as a submarine warfare weapon.

The shells were launched from surface ships in hopes up hitting submerged submarines below. The weapons were phased out as they proved less and less effective against modern nuclear submarines.

"These particular shells were usually armed with 31 pounds of TNT," said AOCs Knapp, of Naval Air Station Key West's Weapons Department.

A weapon with that much TNT presented a safety hazard and would have to be destroyed, according to Chief Warrant Officer Angel Torres, weapons officer. "We already had an Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD) unit in the area," he added. "EOD Mobile Unit Six was already in the area to destroy a few sticks of dynamite used for police dog training."

The Hedgehog's fragmentation area was too large to be destroyed at Boca Chica Field's emergency blow area so the operation had to move to Fleming Key, Torres said. "The detonation site was near Bldg. F-644, the former vehicle holding area.

In order to reduce the fragmentation area from 1,800 ft to 600 ft, we had the ordnance placed in a hole six feet deep. The ordnance was then, 'rendered safe,' using C-4 explosives to detonate it."

The ordnance was "rendered safe" at 1 p.m. Tuesday, without mishap, Torres said.

NMCI Phase Two nears at NAS Key West

Final preparations and checks are in full swing at Naval Air Station Key West as the base readies to "connect" and become the latest addition to the Navy Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI).

The Navy Marine Corps Intranet will become the world's largest intranet connecting over 700,000 computer users with a secure computer environment for accomplishing the Navy's mission. Making the connection involves a three-phase approach. For the past year, Naval Air Station (NAS) Key West has been busy identifying users, network engineering and computer and software needs. Phase Two is beginning over the next two weeks. Contractors from EDS, the company selected to build and maintain the NMCI, will arrive in Key West to complete the buildout necessary for the operation of NMCI. These

activities include furnishing, installing, and testing the NMCI site enterprise, and beginning infrastructure work in order to finalize implementation and cutover plans. NAS Key West is targeted to begin cutover to join the rest of the Navy and Marine Corps on the network in early October. During this final phase, the air station and computer users will move from the current network, also known as the legacy environment, to the NMCI environment. Workstations will be replaced and user data migrated to new servers as Key West becomes a part of the NMCI infrastructure.

"It's essential that air station personnel review their computer needs and software they're using now," said Gidget Johns, director of NAS Key West's information technology department. "We need to know if you are using specific software to complete mission essential work. Under the NMCI environment, only specific software applications can be used. If you are using software that is not approved for NMCI use, you will not be allowed to use it."

NMCI provides a secure intranet for Navy users. Because of security safeguards, only NMCI approved software can be utilized. Sailors and Navy civilians can review a list of NMCI approved software online at:

<http://www.nmci-eds.com>. According to Johns, if your software isn't listed, you're going to need to figure out how to do your job using approved software.

Johns also said NMCI will change the way computer problems on base are handled. "Users will be calling in computer problems to a Navy-wide help desk rather than a local help desk," she said. She further explained that NMCI workstations, designed in some basic configurations with common

software, will mean fewer wide spread problems. "Right now, legacy computer systems can cause troubleshooting problems because no two computers are exactly the same on a non-NMCI network."

News reporting about NMCI user satisfaction is mixed. Not everyone is happy with NMCI and they complain about slower computer access than what they used to have. For some Sailors and Navy civilians here, the improvement will be immediately felt. They will have a computer account and e-mail address that won't change when they travel or transfer.

"Anytime you buy a new computer or transfer to a new command with a different computer network, there is always going to be frustration because you won't be able to do what you used to be able to do; now you will - the Navy will be the same wherever you go, including your e-mail address.

Expect frustration with NMCI when it arrives but cooperate and participate in the implementation; learn the new system and you'll get over the frustration faster. This is the system the Navy chose and this is the system you will use wherever you go in the Navy," said Johns.

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New program aims to help military spouses interested in teaching

WASHINGTON — Spouses to Teachers, DoD's latest endeavor to assist military spouses interested in teaching, is serving a similar purpose as the popular Troops to Teachers (TTT) program, an official said.

DoD established Troops to Teachers in 1994, and responsibility for the program was recently transferred to the U.S. Department of Education. TTT was created to help recruit quality teachers for schools that serve low-income families throughout America, according to the Troops to Teachers Web site.

Michael Melo, director of a Spouses to Teachers pilot program in Virginia, explained that TTT laid the groundwork for STT in providing individual state information. Melo is also the director of Virginia's TTT program.

STT is currently a pilot program in six states: California, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Texas and Virginia. The program was prompted by military spouses who were already teachers or interested in teaching, but were facing difficulties finding certification requirements and job information when they moved, Gary Woods, acting director of DoD educational opportunities, said.

Melo and Woods said the program would offer information, counseling and guidance to eligible, interested individuals. Initially, eligibility is limited to those with a bachelor's degree who are spouses of active-duty service members and members of the Selected Reserve or Individual Ready Reserve on extended duty.

It will also offer limited financial assistance to help defray the costs of meeting state certification requirements in the pilot states.

On the future STT Web site and in offices that will be handling the program, the goal is to provide information on teacher-certification requirements within a state, what kinds of jobs are available, and what kind of reciprocity exists between the system they're currently teaching in and systems they may potentially be transferring into, Woods said.

Because of that established network, the Virginia STT office is able to help transferring spouses become aware of how they may need to augment their certification, as certifications are not always accepted in a different school system, Melo said.

"Because of the network we have from Troops to Teachers with the Department of Education, with the school districts, with the colleges, we're able to provide that information that the spouses need on what they need to do to be certified in a particular state," Melo said. "If it has reciprocity, there are always intricate little details that it doesn't necessarily transfer over completely."

Even before the Web site has

been posted, the response has been positive, Melo said. "We're actually surprised at the number of phone calls we've already received."

Already, four spouses are in the Virginia pilot program, and one has entered an academic program that will lead to licensure.

While the program serves spouses interested in teaching, it also helps ease the burden of a national teacher shortage. The benefits, however, are not limited to the schools that stand to get quality teachers out of the program. The students reap rewards, as well.

Like the former troops who take up chalk and eraser, military spouses bring some of the same skills to the classroom.

"The military spouse has a variety of life experiences that they've gained as a military spouse," Melo said. "So when they come into the classroom, they bring those same experiences so they can impart those life experiences in the learning process of the students."

Military families can come out ahead, too. Woods said this provides an opportunity for a spouse to pursue a degree and a career that will provide the family a better income over time. "One of the things that we're primarily interested in right now is providing access to careers for spouses that will enhance the family bottom line," he said.



Guantanamo Bay base has storied past

NAVAL BASE GUANTANAMO BAY, Cuba, Aug. 24, 2004 — The eyes of the world are focused on this remote Navy base as hearings begin in the first four military commissions for detainees from the war on terrorism.

But the base's commander, Navy Capt. Les McCoy, wants people to know his end of the island is "not a penal colony."

"This is a community that happens to have a maximum-security prison attached to it," he said.

At 101 years old, Naval Base Guantanamo Bay is America's oldest active overseas military base. The positioning of a prison for enemy combatants from the

war on terrorism has focused attention on, and led to the revitalization of, a base that had been in a period of decline. The population of the base has tripled in the past two and a half years, McCoy said.

Set up as a naval coaling station, "Gitmo," as the base is affectionately known, evolved into a refueling station as technology advanced. The base was leased in 1903 for \$2,000 per year on a perpetual basis. In 1934, the lease was renegotiated to \$4,085 per year.

The U.S. State Department sends a check to the Cuban government every July, but, McCoy said, Cuban dictator Fidel Castro has only cashed one — in 1959, the year he took power.

The base plays host to three categories of Cubans.

At one time, the base permanently housed thousands of Cuban exiles who had worked on the U.S. end of the island.

Should you stay or should you go?

The Navy is getting smaller — you've probably heard that. In the coming years, the Navy will shed about 50,000 Sailors. Reducing the Navy's manpower is a key part of the CNO's plan to recapitalize financial assets to build the leaner, trimmer Navy of tomorrow. If you're one of the thousands of Sailors looking to get out of the Navy early, or perhaps looking for a different kind of adventure, there are two plans in place that you might want to consider.

In July the Navy introduced the FY-04 Early Transition Program in NAVADMIN 151-04. The program allows qualified Sailors to exit the service up to

12 months early. The deadline for submission is September 15, 2004. This program is open to all Sailors, with the following exceptions: Sailors under a Selective Reenlistment Bonus contract or in a rating/NEC eligible for SRB reenlistment; Sailors in SEAL/EOD/DIVER/SWCC programs; Sailors in nuclear ratings; or any Sailors in ratings/NECs under any stop-loss order. The Navy is hoping thousands of Sailors take advantage of the early-out program. If you're interested, see your career counselor today!

The other program that is gaining interest is Operation Blue to Green. This program affords Sailors the opportunity to cross over to the Army. The Navy has 112 ratings that

directly correlate to 42 Army MOSs. The primary focus is Sailors E1-E5, but the Army is willing to entertain requests from any paygrade on a case-by-case basis.

One of the benefits of transferring to the Army is enhanced advancement opportunity. Because the Army is growing and the Navy is shrinking, it's easy to see the possibly advantage of becoming a Soldier. The Army's recruiting goal for FY-05 is about 80,000 Soldiers. They are looking for the Navy and Air Force to recruit about 8,000 Sailors and Airmen. If you are interested, see your career counselor today!

Both of the new programs will help us reduce the Navy's end strength. But before you decide to leave the Navy or swap over to the Army, I would like to challenge every Sailor to think long and hard about the decision.

I firmly believe the Navy isn't for everyone, and sometimes people enter the Navy only to find out it's really not for them. But, in other instances, Sailors

sometimes fail to fully recognize how important they are to our team. I find that unfortunate because no matter how large or small the Navy becomes, Sailors will continue to be our number one asset. Sailors need to know they matter, and that the training we have provided them is important.

If leaving the Navy is an easy decision, I have to ask, "What went wrong?" Somewhere along the line something broke down. The Navy has a thing called "covenant leadership." What this implies is that those senior in the Navy make a concerted effort to form a bond with its new Sailors and to shape and cultivate them.

When a Sailor joins the Navy, they expect something back, not just in training, but also in commitment. If that didn't happen, I guess I can understand why someone might not want to be part of the Navy team.

If you are one of those people, at least do yourself a favor — make sure you weigh your options fairly. I have heard

many Sailors say they want to leave the Navy to go to college or to work in the civilian world where they can make more money. While I don't doubt their intentions, the question I always ask is, "What is your plan?" Too often Sailors on the threshold of departure lack the necessary details of their plan.

You owe it to yourself to ask that question to yourself and ensure you have concrete answers. Your chain of command should be asking you those very same questions.

Shipmates, I truly hope everyone sees the merit in reducing our end strength. Our future is extremely bright. It will be filled with opportunity and technology that will make our jobs more challenging, and more fun.

For those of you who remain on the team, I can only hope you look to the future and are as excited as I am. For those who desire to depart the Navy, whether as a civilian or a Soldier, I wish you well and hope you always speak favorably about our sea service.

Today there are 61, including 34 individuals who have been there since Castro took the country's reins in 1959. Forty of the 61 are naturalized U.S. citizens.

McCoy explained that many of these people never wanted to leave their homeland but also refused to live in a communist state. "We are obligated to care for them," the captain said, adding that Guantanamo Bay may be the only U.S. military installation with an assisted-living facility to

care for elderly residents.

A second category of Cubans on the naval base is referred to as "commuters." In pre-communist Cuba, Cuban citizens entered the base each day to work for the U.S. government. When the communists came to power, they allowed those already employed here to continue that employment, but no others were allowed to accept jobs here. Over time, an elaborate system evolved for these commuters to leave communist Cuba each morning and return in the evening via the base's

North East Gate.

In 1959 there were roughly 3,500 such commuters each day. Today there are three, all between the ages of 75 and 83, McCoy said.

The commuters also have a unique responsibility to other commuters who have retired and are due pensions from the U.S. government. Since the Cuban and American governments have no diplomatic ties, monetary transfers are not possible. The commuters are paid in cash and carry cash pension payments across the border for

the others who have retired, the captain explained.

The third category of Cubans on the U.S. base are migrants who are either interdicted at sea by the U.S. Coast Guard or asylum seekers who make it across the border by land or by water. They live in migrant facilities on the base and often take jobs while here. If officials find the interdictees or asylum seekers have legitimate grounds to be granted asylum, they are eventually moved to a third-party country, generally in Latin America.

The migrant facilities also

house Haitian immigrants who are interdicted at sea, McCoy said.

Despite the attention paid to the prison, McCoy said the detention facility has been good for the base. "It's brought life back to the community," he said.

Today about 8,500 Americans call Gitmo home, including 3,000 U.S. military servicemembers. Nine hundred to 1,000 family members, including about 500 children, accompany the military members.

"We're a small American town," McCoy said. "We think we're a throwback to the '50s."

Rifle shooter wins U.S. military's first 2004 Olympic Medal

ATHENS, Greece, Aug. 23, 2004 - Army Maj. Michael Anti won a silver medal Aug. 22 in men's 50-meter three-position rifle shooting in the 2004 Summer Olympic Games.

"I wish I had the gold, but I'm just excited to have a medal," said Anti, 40, of Winterville, N.C., who is assigned to the Army Marksmanship Unit at Fort Benning, Ga. "We have such a great unit and such a great Army for them to allow me to do this. There are people overseas risking their life to allow me to compete here, so it's a big deal."

China's Zhanbo Jia won the gold medal with 1,264.5 points. Anti, a marksman in the Army World Class Athlete Program, took the silver medal with 1,263.1 points. Austria's Christian Planer claimed the bronze medal with a 1,262.8 total.

Anti entered the final round in seventh place. After shooting marks of 10.4, 8.8, 9.3 and 10.6, he moved into fourth place with a 10.8 on his fifth of 10 shots in the finale. An 8.5 on his ensuing shot, however, cost him dearly. He quickly rebounded with marks of 10.4 and 10.8 to move into third place. Then an 8.1 dropped him back to fourth. He capped the performance with a 10.4.

"For me, it was kind of up and down," Anti said of his final round. "I'd shoot a good 10 and then I'd shoot an 8, then shoot a good 10 and shoot an 8. None of the shots were really bad shots; I just was late on the trigger," he said. "If I caught it a millisecond before, it could've been a 10. I'm just thrilled to death that I won the silver with my final."

Navy's Nuzum places sixth in double sculls rowing

SCHINIAS, Greece (NNS) — Lt. j.g. Henry Nuzum teamed with Aquil Abdullah to finish sixth in the men's double sculls rowing "A" final Aug. 21 in the 2004 Summer Olympic Games.

France's Sebastien Vielledent and Adrien Hardy won the gold medal in the 2,000-meter event at Schinias Olympic Rowing and Canoeing Centre. Slovenia's Luke Spik and Iztok Cop won the silver medal. Estonia's Rossano Galtarossa and Alessio Sartori took the bronze medal.

Two-time Olympian Nuzum,

27, of Chapel Hill, N.C., and Abdullah, 31, of Washington, D.C., were clocked in 6:36.86.

"It was a good race, probably a notch up on the semi," said Nuzum, attached to the Navy Recruiting District in Philadelphia. "This was probably our best race of the year. It wasn't perfect, but not many crews race perfect."

"We thought a very challenging but attainable goal would be to make the Olympic final," he said. "When we did that (Aug. 18), we kind of shifted our gears and said we wanted to be in the middle of the pack and maybe pick off somebody for bronze, but it didn't work out that way."

Nuzum, a graduate of Yale University and Surface Warfare Officer School, tipped his hat to Navy Sports Director John Hickock at Millington, Tenn., crediting his chance to compete in the Olympics to the Navy's "100 percent" support.

Military and the Olympics—Becoming a military Olympian

WASHINGTON — Many athletes dream of standing atop an Olympic medal podium. However, without the necessary support, even the slightest chance of that happening is a long shot.

Military athletes can find that support within their respective services. Though none of the services' programs are the same, there are similarities.

The Army and Air Force each have two sports programs avail-

able to serious athletes.

The Army's All-Army (Sports Program) chooses a number of athletes for any of about 20 sports and sends them to a three-week trial camp, said Karen White, chief of the Army Sports, Fitness and World Class Athlete Program. If they make the cut there, they become a member of the All-Army team for their given sport.

The All-Army team then competes in the Armed Forces championships. Performance at this level decides placement on the All-Service team, which competes international military championships organized by the Conseil International du Sport Militaire, or better known as CISM.

According to Air Force sports chief Steve Brown, the Air Force Sports Program is nearly identical. Athletes are selected from a pool of applications to attend a training camp and, upon selection, join an All-Air Force team.

With skill and luck, it's on to the All-Service team and CISM competitions.

Both services also run a World Class Athlete Program designed to help nationally ranked athletes train toward a goal of competing in the Olympics. Duration and location are the two biggest differences between the services' programs.

The Army allows for a training period of three years prior to the Olympics. Air Force athletes are limited to two years. As for location, the Army WCAP is located at Fort Carson, Colo., near the Olympic training site, while the Air Force lets athletes train where it's best for them.

The Navy and the Marine Corps' support structures for athletes are quite different from those of the Army and Air Force. Neither has a WCAP, nor do they actively recruit athletes.

For the Navy, once an athlete is identified as being of Olympic caliber, he or she must request a special assignment consideration, John Hickok, head of Navy sports, said. Training usually begins about 18 months before the Games.

If a Marine Corps athlete is invited by a sport's national governing body to participate at a training center, he or she then

becomes a member of the corps' National Caliber Athlete Program, Steve Dinote, director of Marine Corps sports, said.

A Marine athlete is not allowed to train for more than three and a half years without returning to the fleet, Dinote said.

Training expenses are always a concern for an athlete. And all four services offer some type of financial assistance to their athletes. That assistance is usually in the form of entry fees, transportation and lodging associat-

ed with competition to advance their goals.

"If you're saying you're going to support (athletes), then you have to support them with the minimum to make the team," White said.

If a sport's national governing body taps an athlete for training, that concern over training costs becomes less urgent.

Each service had at least one athlete qualified to participate in the 2004 Summer Olympic Games in Athens, which began Aug 13.
